We have 2 Celts and Moorland chests, A Climate Change chest and from our Historical Healers Project we also have a massive resource pack for you to use, all free of Charge (£50 deposit required to cover breakages and losses, refundable upon return inspection)

This year we are running two workshops **Celts** and **Climate change** to demonstrate the contents of the chests and run through ideas and activities for you to bring these subjects to life.

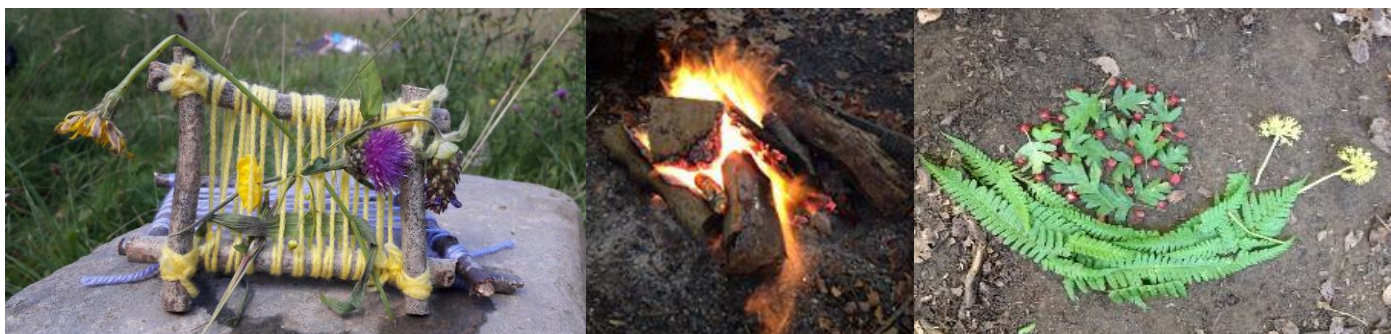
Did you know?
